



## **Bath Motor Club Championship – 2025 – 2026 Regulations**

1. The Bath Motor Club Championship will consist of up to 18 rounds of different events set out by the Bath Motor Club Committee. These events can be either social or competitive but may also include other events that are deemed appropriate by the committee and / or the Championship Co-ordinator.
2. The Bath Motor Club Championship will run from the 1st September 2025 until 31st August 2026. The dates of events will be determined by the organisers.
3. The list of Championship events will be published as early as possible. The list of events and dates may change providing they meet the criteria as set out in item 1 and item 2.
4. If an event's date has to be re-arranged, the new date must be published at least 1 month before the date of the event. If the date is changed within 1 month of the event, then this event may be lost from the Championship, and competitors and organisers may NOT be eligible for Championship points, when the event runs on the revised date. In all cases it is the event organisers responsibility to notify the club of any date change and to advertise this to club members. Any objections to a date change once the championship has begun should be addressed to the committee, where the committee has the final decision.
5. To qualify for points within the Championship, you must be a registered member of Bath Motor Club on the day of the event. Membership can be applied for on the day of the event, and you may be eligible for points depending on the individual event regulation. Standing order mandates are available to guarantee membership from the start of the club year, 1st September. Please obtain one from the Membership Secretary.
6. The allocation of points for competitors is as follows for overall position:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> - 12 points
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> - 11 points
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> - 10 points
  - 4<sup>th</sup> - 9 points
  - 5<sup>th</sup> - 8 points
  - 6<sup>th</sup> - 7 points
  - 7<sup>th</sup> - 6 points
  - 8<sup>th</sup> - 5 points
  - 9<sup>th</sup> - 4 points
  - 10<sup>th</sup> - 3 points
  - All remaining competitors - 2 points
  - Non – finisher - 1 point

Points will be awarded for the finishing position on an event, not for the positions of championship contenders or other categories within the event. However, where an event runs both a Clubman and RS Interclub, finishers in both sections will score points as above.

7. There will be NO allocation of points retrospectively. The date of membership registration is that as set down by the Membership Secretary.
8. Points for officials / marshals etc. will be allocated as below:

Event set up / pack down on a day previous or post event = 6 points/day  
Marshalling on a Bath MC Championship event = 6 points  
Any role other role at an event which has a key or important part in the event = 6 points  
Manning the Bath MC stand at Exhibition Days = 6 points  
Castle Combe Action days = 2 points per day  
Published article in the club news or website = 4 points per article  
Attending organised Co-Forest tree planting = 5 point per day  
Assisting with pack down of event (not just one marshal location) = 2 points

Should a member take on more than one role on any event, points will only be allocated at the highest number of points available. The only exception to this is for pack down points which will be allocated on top. Pack down points will not be added on top of set up team points.

9. The master copy of Championship points will be held by the Championship Co-ordinator. The Championship positions will be published at regular intervals on the Bath Motor Club Website and via the round robin newsletter / email. All queries on allocation of points must be made in writing (e-mails accepted) to the Championship Co-ordinator. The Championship Co-ordinator will contact the event organiser if clarification is required, where the final decision will be determined from the signing on sheet for marshals and competitors. If a suitable outcome cannot be determined, then the final decision on point allocation shall be made by the Bath Motor Club Committee.
10. In the event of a tie, (in any position) then the highest place position will be determined by the following criteria: -
  - (i) Total number of events where points were awarded.
  - (ii) Highest score from first round entered
  - (iii) Highest score from second round entered(criteria ii / iii will continue through the rounds until the tie is resolved)
11. The top three positions in the Bath Motor Club Championship will win the following awards:
  - 1st The Les Hukins Trophy
  - 2nd Ernie Waldron Trophy
  - 3rd Jane Aibl Trophy

The awards will be presented at the Bath Motor Club Annual Prize Presentation and remain the property of Bath Motor Club, and must be returned prior to the next Prize Presentation

12. The highest placed under 18 will be awarded a free 12-month membership to Bath Motor Club for the following club year.

To be eligible for this, you must be under the age of 18 throughout the club year. Determination of who is eligible will be between the Membership Secretary and Competition Co-ordinator.

13. The highest placed new member of Bath Motor Club will be awarded a free 12-month membership to Bath Motor Club for the following club year.

To be eligible for this, you must not have been a member of Bath Motor Club prior to the current club year. The determination of new members will be from the Membership Secretary.

14. These rules shall be ratified and amended as necessary each year by the Committee of Bath Motor Club.

15. Any member who does not wish to be included within the championship should email the championship co-ordinator and events will not count until further communication is given to the co-ordinator wishing to be included.

16. Organisers of events must email the Championship Coordinator after the event with a list of Bath Motor Club members who took part including positions as well as official's roles.
