



Bath Motor Club Competition Championship 2026

1. The Bath Motor Club Competition Championship is open to any Bath Motor Club member competing in any 4wheel FIA and Motorsport UK recognised motor sport event, with the exception of scatters and treasure hunts.
2. The championship will run from the 1st January 2026 until 31st December 2026.
3. The Championship will be based on taking part in a maximum of 10 events. Should you compete in more than 10, your best 10 scores will count.

In the event of a tie, the highest scoring first round will be the decider, moving onto the second round until the tie has been decided.

4. Current members can take part in any form of 4 wheeled FIA and Motorsport UK recognised motorsport. Points will be awarded the same for all categories. For example; Should the event be International, National, Interclub or Clubman's status, you will be awarded the same points throughout, based on your overall position.

However, for Racing/Sprint/Hillclimb, points will be awarded by class results. In addition, for WRC or ERC events, results will be taken from the category result not the overall i.e. WRC 1, 2, 3 or 4.

If you enter as a Clubman in an event that has both Interclub and Clubman, you will be awarded points based on results of the Clubman event.

5. Points will be awarded as follows:
Within 10 days of the event please complete the online form which will be returned upon submission to the championship co-ordinator. The form is on the Bath Motor Club website under championship.

6. Allocation of points are as follows

1 st Place	50 points
2 nd place	49 points
3 rd place	48 points

This decreases to 49th place and awarded 2 points

If you started the event but did not finish you will be allocated 1 point.

7. **Sub-category: Marshalling points**

Points will be awarded to any Bath Motor Club Member who marshals or completes an official role in any FIA and Motorsport UK recognised event as follows:

- Clubman event – 10 points
- National event – 20 points
- International event – 30 points

AMENDMENT 23/02/2026: Marshals who complete marshal training days will also be allocated points as below:

- **Each full day – 10 points**
- **Each half day – 5 points**

Please provide proof of attendance via signing on sheet, email confirmation of attendance or picture of signed marshal book.

For points to be awarded please follow the same process as point 5, however instead of providing a copy of the results, please sent a copy of the signing on form for the event (a photo of signing on form is accepted), or confirmation email for signing on for the event and please provide the event status (i.e. clubman etc).

This sub-category of the competition championship will also be subject to an award for the highest total points marshalling, however will not count towards the overall award for the competition championship.

In the event of a tie, it will be decided on the highest placed first round, moving to the second round until a tie is decided.

- 1st place – An award

8. Championship Awards

- 1st place – An award
- 2nd place – An award
- 3rd place – An award

Anyone in the top three cannot win more than one award.

Further to the overall awards, there will be awards for the highest total points achieved in the following event type categories over the course of the competition. These awards will not be subject to drop scores, and total of all events competed in the category will count.

- 1st place in Rally
- 1st place in Targa
- 1st place in 12 car
- 1st place in AutoSOLO / Autotest

The following awards can also be won as well as any other award above. However, one person cannot win both of the below awards. In this scenario one award will be presented, and the other award will go to second place.

- 1st Newcomer (1st year as Bath Motor Club member) – An award + 12 months free membership
- 1st Junior – An award + 12 months free membership

9. These regulations will not be subject to any protest. Final allocation of points will be decided by the championship co-ordinator.
