## Bath Motor Club Competition Championship 2024

1. The Bath Motor Club Competition Championship is open to any Bath Motor Club member competing in any 4wheel FIA and Motorsport UK recognised motor sport.
2. The championship will run from the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024 until 31<sup>st</sup> December 2024.
3. The Championship will be based on taking part in a maximum of 8 events. Should you compete in more than 8, your best 8 scores will count.
4. Current club members must show proof of carrying a Bath Motor Club sticker on the external part of the car (this is available from the championship secretary) and take part in any form of 4 wheeled FIA and Motorsport UK recognised motorsport. Points will be awarded the same for all categories. For example; Should the event be International, National, Interclub or Clubman's status, you will be awarded the same points throughout, based on your overall position. Class and group positions are not considered.

For clarification, if you entered an interclub event, but competed in the clubman section, you will be awarded points in the clubman section if the event is deemed a separate event, otherwise it will be based on overall results.

5. Points will be awarded as follows:  
The Championship Secretary must receive within 10 days of the event the following:

Date and name of event plus organising club  
Status of event  
Proof of results of the event

6. Allocation of points are as follows

1<sup>st</sup> Place            50 points

2<sup>nd</sup> place            49 points

3<sup>rd</sup> place            48 points

This decreases to 49<sup>th</sup> place and awarded 2 points

If you started the event but did not finish you will be allocated 1 point.

7. Championship Awards

1<sup>st</sup> place - An award

2<sup>nd</sup> place – An award

3<sup>rd</sup> place – An award

Anyone in the top three cannot win more than one award.

1<sup>st</sup> Lady - An award

1<sup>st</sup> under 21 – An award

8. These regulations will not be subject to any protest. Final allocation of points will be decided by the championship secretary.
