

NAVIGATIONAL SCATTER - FRIDAY 28th February 2025

1. Bath Motor Club Limited will organise a Navigational Scatter event on **FRIDAY 28th February 2025**.

Bath Motor Club would like to extend this invitation to any members of Bath Motor Club, Devizes and District Motor Club, White Horse Motor Club, Tavern Motor Club, Weston Motor Club and Burnham on Sea Motor Club.

2. Please be aware of the new ruling re competition licences. All Motorsport UK Permitted events. All competitor and passengers must hold a RS Clubmans licence, See Item 12 below
3. This event will be a round of the 2024/2025 Bath Motor Club and DDMC Championship.
4. The meeting is held under the General Regulations of the MSUK and these Supplementary Regulations.
5. The Start and Finish of the event will be at The Masons Arms , Marstons Gate, Marstons Road, Frome, BA11 4DJ 183/ 765 462
6. You should expect to cover approximately 60/80 miles. There is no set route.
7. **Start times.** Entrants will receive the route between 7.00pm-7:15pm. Signing on will be from 6:30pm.
8. Competitors will not be able to start before 7.30pm.

Finish. Will be at 22:00, however, 10 marks will be deducted from final score for each 10 minute or part late arrival.

The event will be decided on a points basis. Points are gained by visiting different locations that are located by various types of navigation.

10 points

15 points

20 points

Evidence of visiting these locations will be by collecting a piece of information from street furniture (e.g. Hydrant numbers, distances on signposts or bridge numbers) that is visible from the car.

There will also be a Travelling marshal, at two locations. A visit to his location will earn only 25 points. He will give you two more locations. Scoring 25 points each You should only visit him at one of his planned locations. These locations and times will be clear in the instructions.

There is no requirement to visit more than 75% of locations as only 75% of correct answers will count.

The entry fee is £10 per car. If the entry is received by the Secretary prior to 5:30pm on Tuesday 25th February 2025 on an official entry Form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. The maximum number of entries for the event is 25, the minimum is 6. Please note that the event may not run if sufficient entries are not received by the pre-closing date of Tuesday 25th Feb. 2025.

The Organisers have applied to Reis Motorsport Insurance a Cover Note under the above scheme. This will provide competitors who need to use the scheme with the Third Party Cover necessary to meet RTA requirements on the Road Sections of the event.

The basic rate for the event before any loadings will be £24.00. All applicants wishing to use the scheme must be able to comply with all points of the Reis Motorsport Insurance Declaration: - which will be available at signing on.

12 Please ensure you get your application in to Motorsport UK for your 2025 licence, to ensure you get it back in time. Entrants will require the new RS Clubman licence which is free of charge <https://rsclubman.motorsportuk.org/>

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- a. Any passenger under the age of 18 must bring a signed parental consent form.
- b. All cars should look as standard as possible and carry a maximum of only two additional driving lights, no advertising on the vehicle, no excessive noise and no multi-coloured vehicles.
- c. All cars must be taxed, insured and where applicable have a current MOT.
- d. Navigators require Torches, pencils, rubber and a roamer together with **OS Landranger Maps 183 and 172 will be required.**
