



Virtual treasure hunt – Bath Motor Club

Hello everyone,

I want to first thank you for taking an interest in this virtual treasure hunt. The idea is to encourage more members to get involved in events, and this virtual treasure hunt can be done from the comfort of your own home, and in your own time. You can work individually or as a team.

The rules are simple. You will need nothing more than google Streetview, What3Words, and some brain power. The questions will ask something, sometimes in a cryptic way meaning you have to use a bit of general knowledge, and will give a location. The location will be given in different ways, sometimes as a postcode, sometimes as a distance from a postcode or What3Words. Once you have worked out the location, then you will need to use google Streetview to 'look around' the area to answer the question. Some of the locations will be harder to locate than others, and we have used italics to indicate a word may have a different meaning to it so you will need to have a think on these.

There are two points available for each question. Some have extra points attached for extra parts of the answer, i.e. time and location. Allocation of points is decided by the organisers who may give half points for a partially correct answer.

The overall position will be determined by the highest points scored. If there is a tie it will be determined by the time that the email was received by the organisers, i.e. first return will be placed higher.

Questions go live at 0800 hours on Tuesday 10th March 2026.

You then have until 1900 hours on Tuesday 7th April 2026 to get your answers in.
