



Virtual treasure hunt – Bath Motor Club

Hello everyone,

I want to first thank you for taking part in this virtual treasure hunt. The rules are simple. You will need nothing more than google Streetview, What3Words, and some brain power.

Once you have worked out the location, then you will need to use google Streetview to 'look around' the area to answer the question. Some of the locations will be harder to locate than others, and we have used italics to indicate a word may have a different meaning to it so you will need to have a think on these.

There are two points available for each question. Some have extra points attached for extra parts of the answer, i.e. time and location. Points available are in brackets. Allocation of points is decided by the organisers who may give one point for a partially correct answer.

The overall position will be determined by the highest points scored. If there is a tie it will be determined by the time that the form was submitted, i.e. first return will be placed higher.
